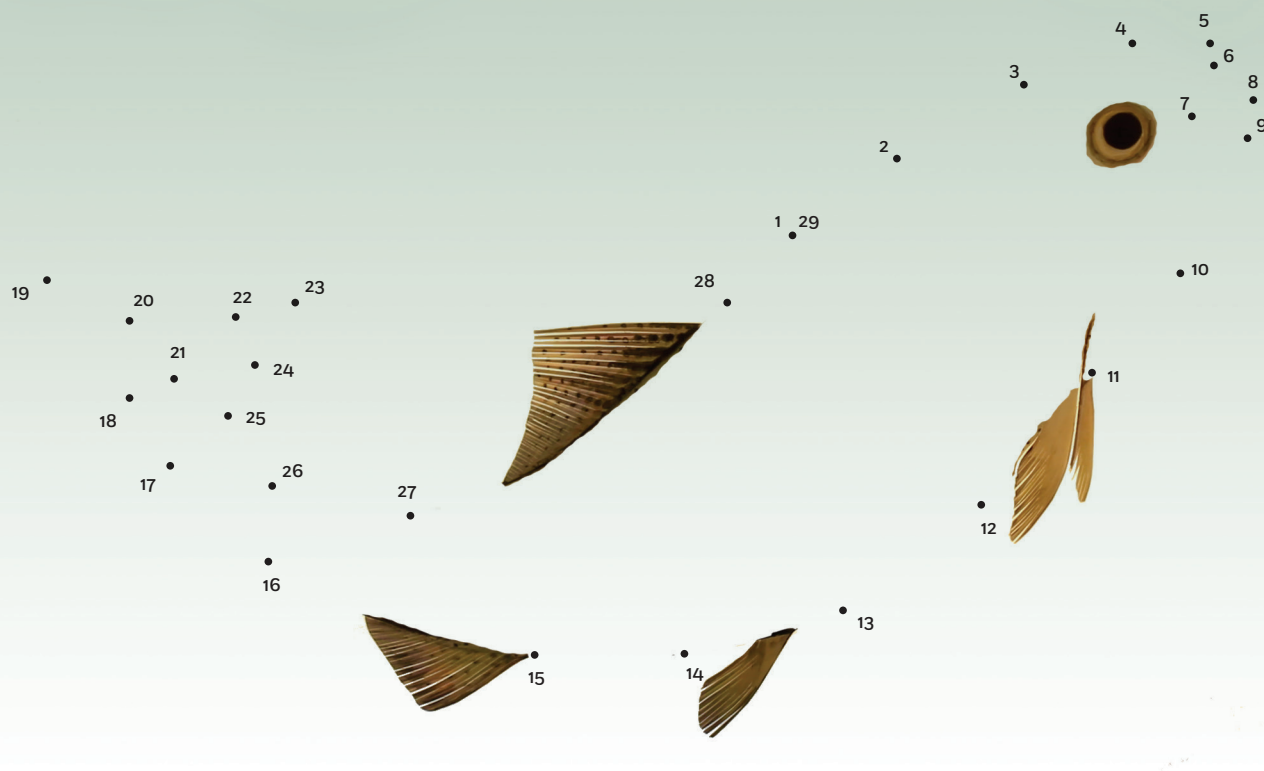

In *Red Sky at Night*, sometimes multiple clues help determine what the weather will be like. Connect the dots to reveal the picture and fill in the blank!

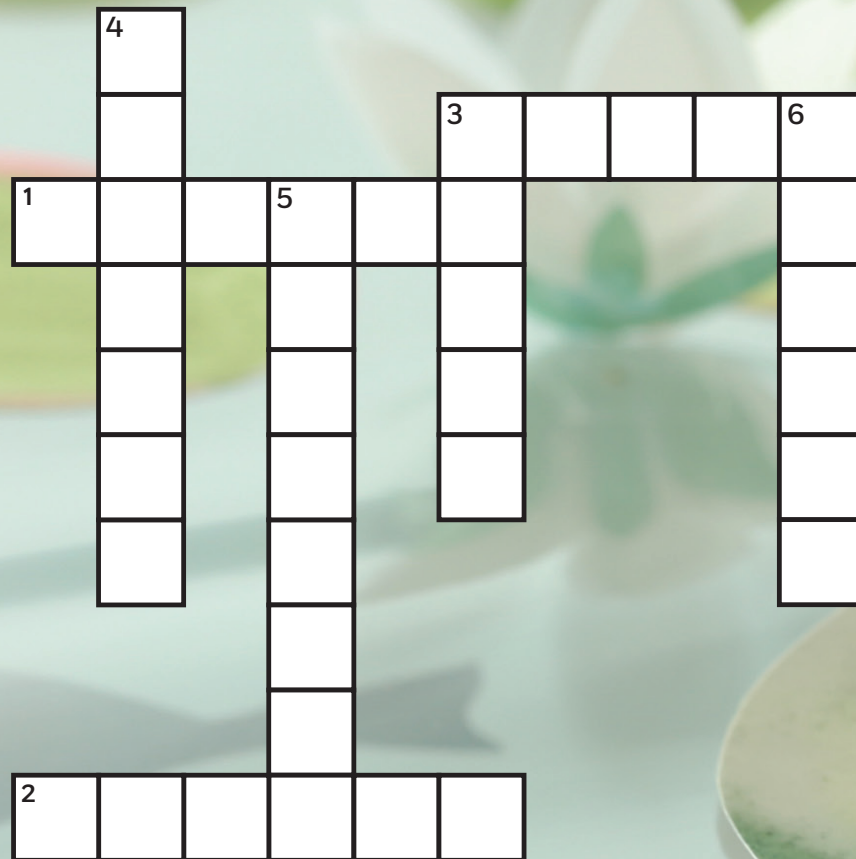
