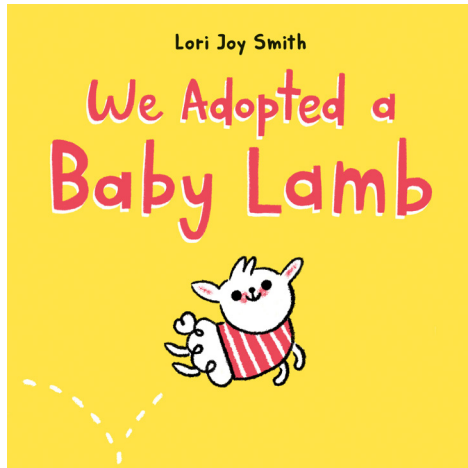

Here are some ideas, activities and questions to consider after you've read the book;

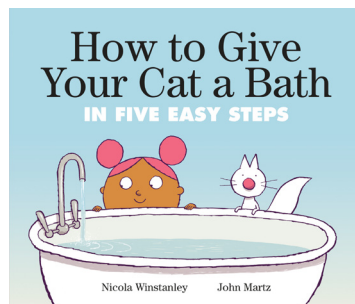
- What is your favorite baby farm animal and why?
