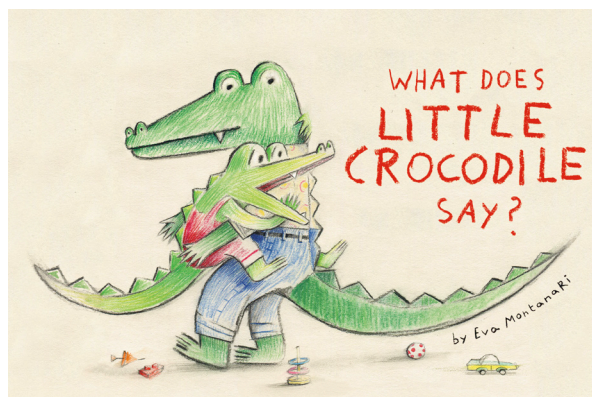

And the crocodile says . . . WAHHHH!

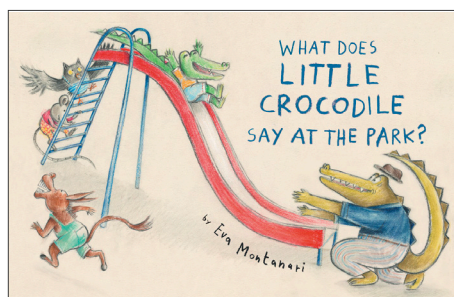

Keep the Conversation Going

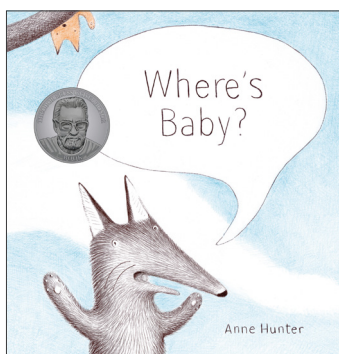
Here are some ideas, activities and questions to consider after you've read the book:

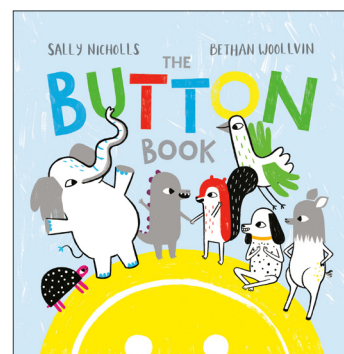

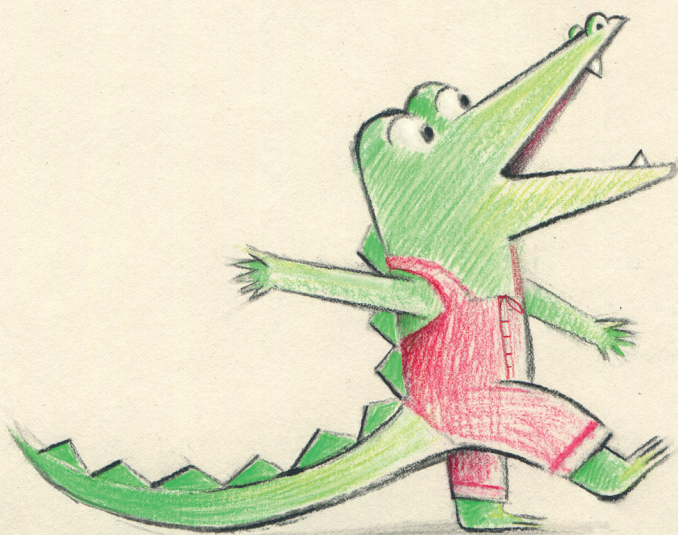
