Her books have consistently garnered her recognition from the American Library Association, the Canadian Library Association and the Canadian Children's Book Centre. *Quid Pro Quo* was shortlisted for an Edgar Award from the Mystery Writers of America and was included as a "Best Book" by the New York Public Library, Bank Street College, and the Canadian Children's Book Centre, and won the Arthur Ellis Award for Best Juvenile Crime fiction in Canada.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you think of the book's title? Can you think of more than one meaning for the title?
2. Tim was in a dilemma: lie to Davida or break his promise to Viv. Do you think he did the right thing?
3. Lots of people had seen Viv after she'd been drinking. Why do you think so few people noticed and/or reported it? Do you think if Viv had been different somehow, people would have been more likely to notice?
4. Why do you think Tim and Davida were attracted to each other?
5. Janice was Dr. Keppo's biggest supporter. Was she totally wrong to support him, or did Dr. Keppo actually do some good in the course of his career? Do you think his crimes negate his accomplishments?
6. How could Viv have coped better with her parents' divorce? Do you know anyone dealing with a similar situation?
7. Do you think Jack and Viv will stay together? Will the fact that she kept such an important secret from him ruin their relationship? How do you think he would have reacted had he known what was actually going on in Viv's life?
8. Viv had a lot of stress in her life. If you were her, what would you have done to deal with it?
9. If you got the chance to ask Vicki Grant one question about *Tell Me When You Feel Something*, what would it be?
10. What did you think of the ending of *Tell Me When You Feel Something*? If you could write an alternate ending, what would happen?
