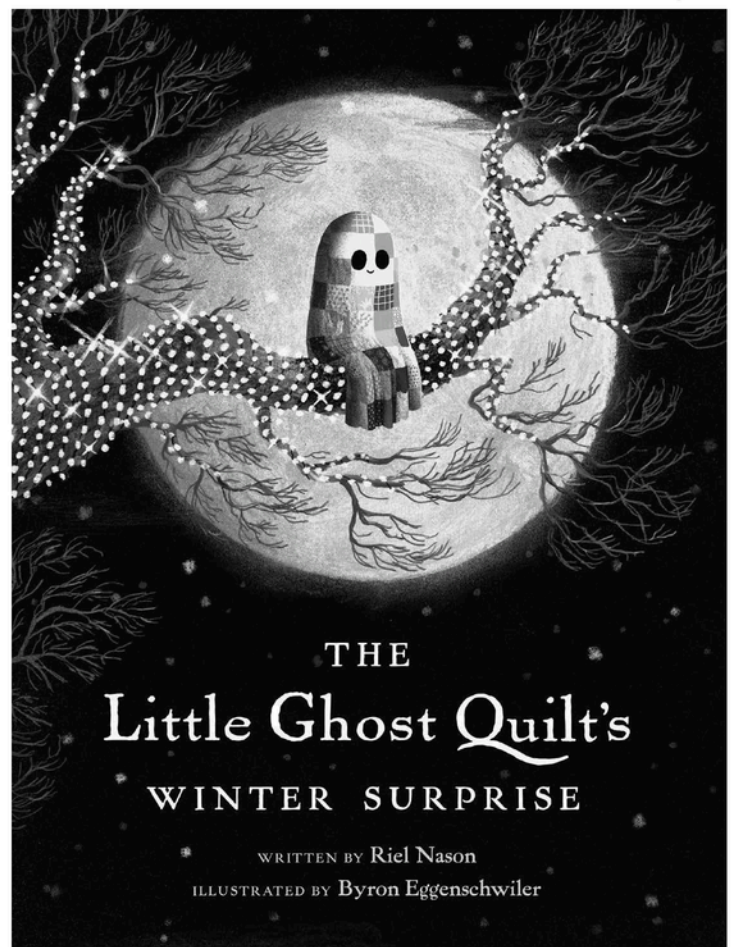
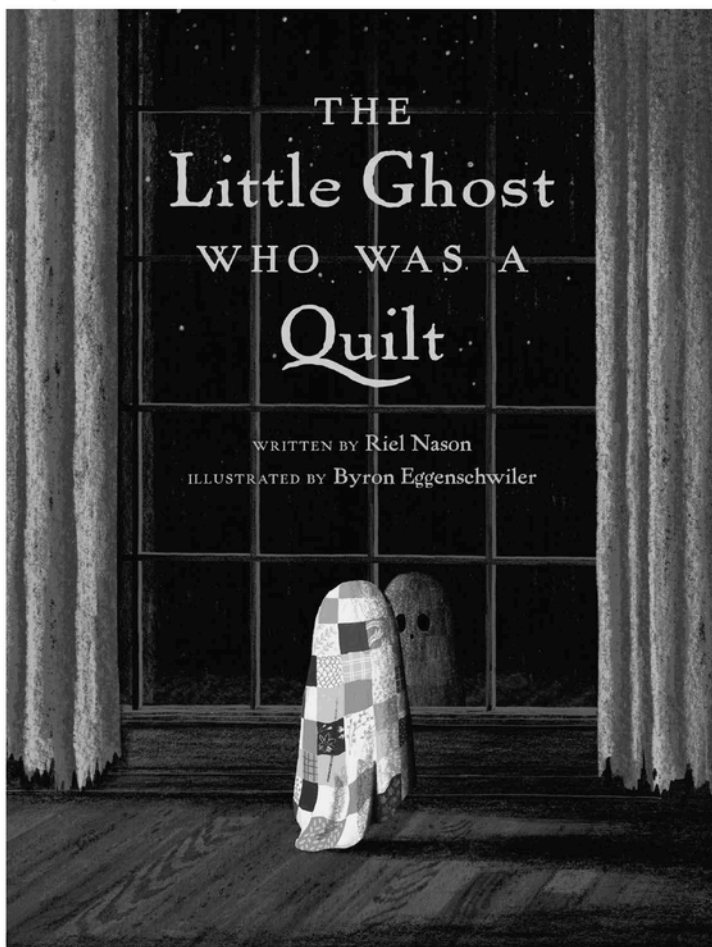

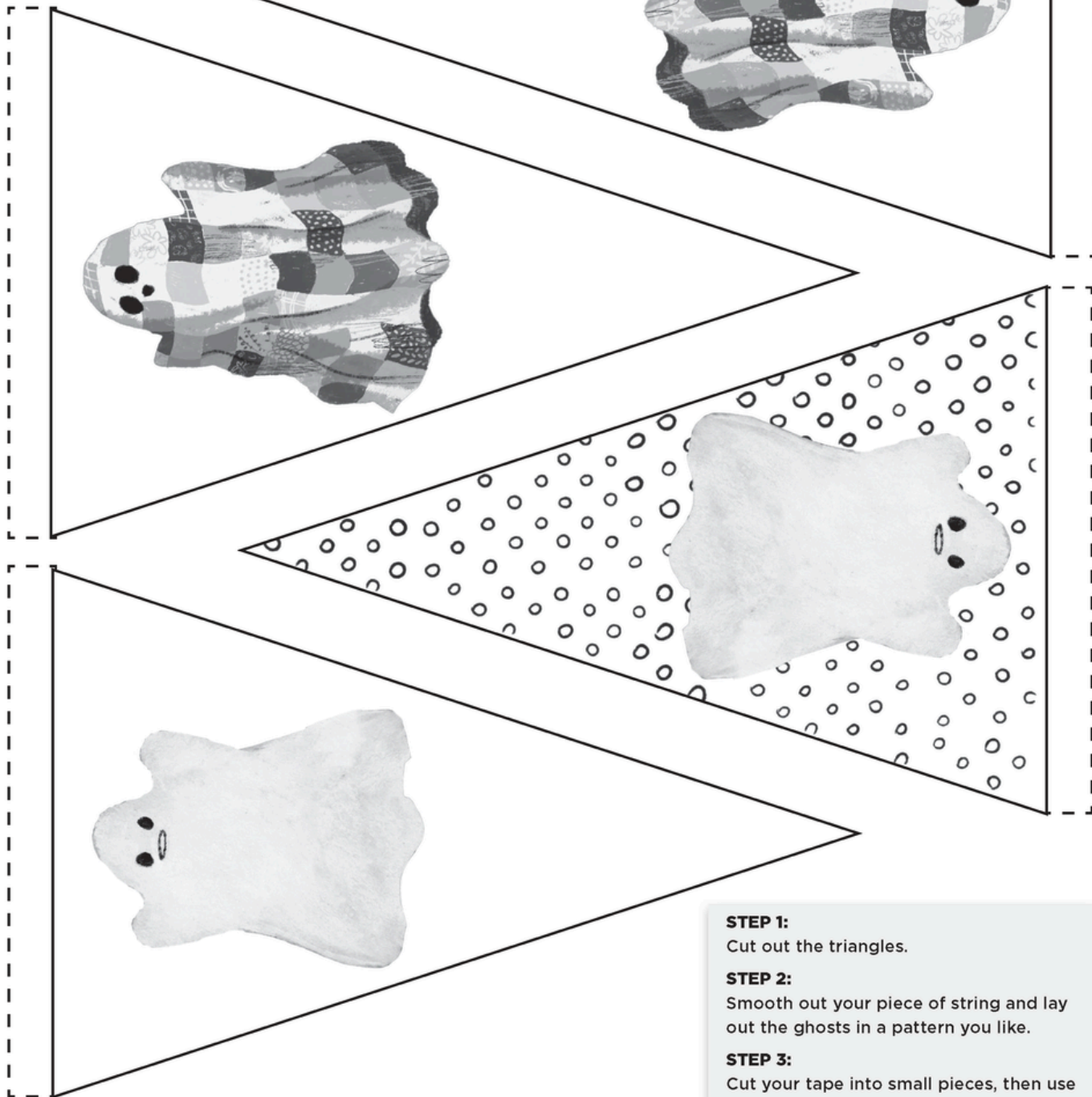

Ghost Bunting

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Scissors
- String
- Tape



STEP 1:

Cut out the triangles.

STEP 2:

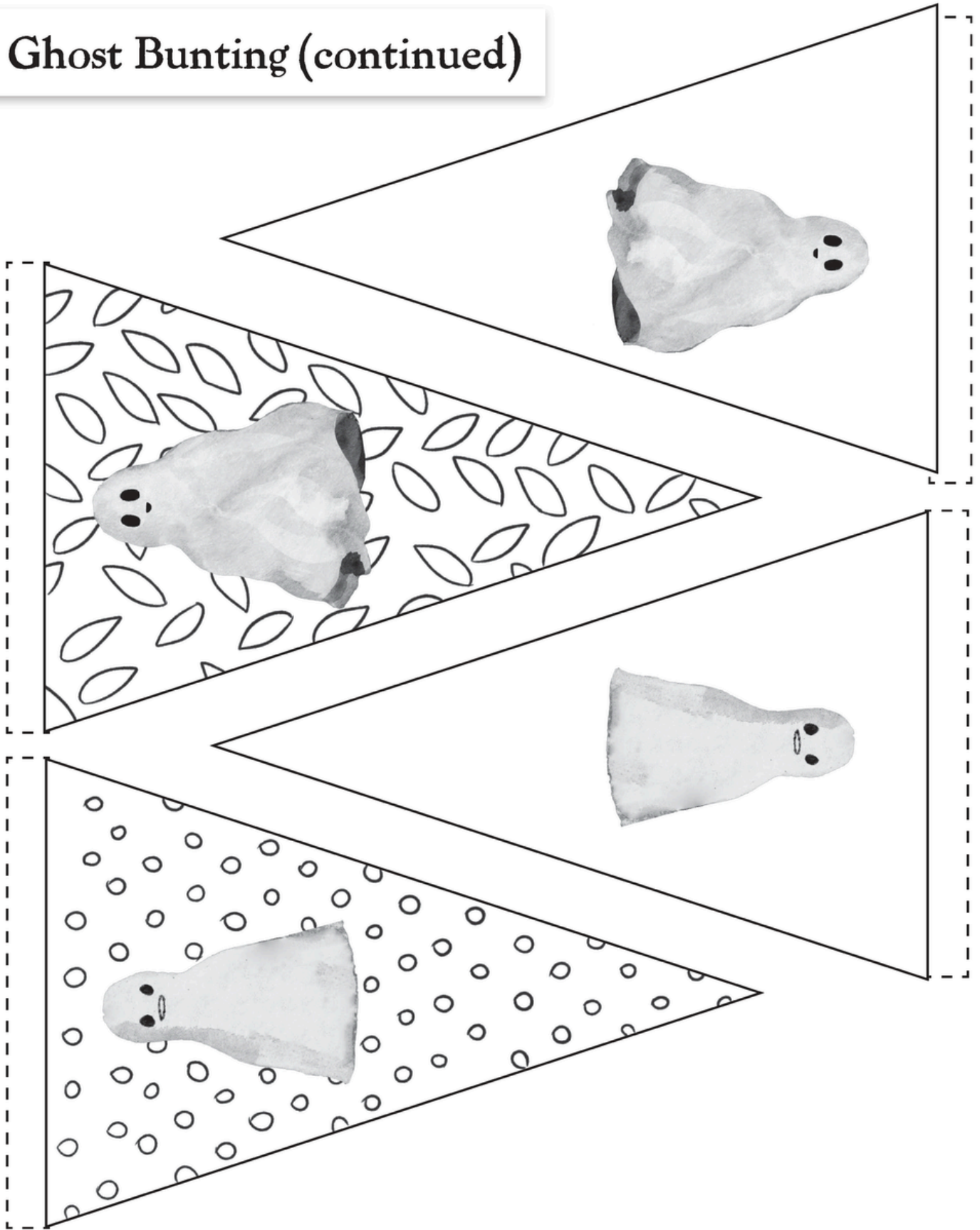
Smooth out your piece of string and lay out the ghosts in a pattern you like.

STEP 3:

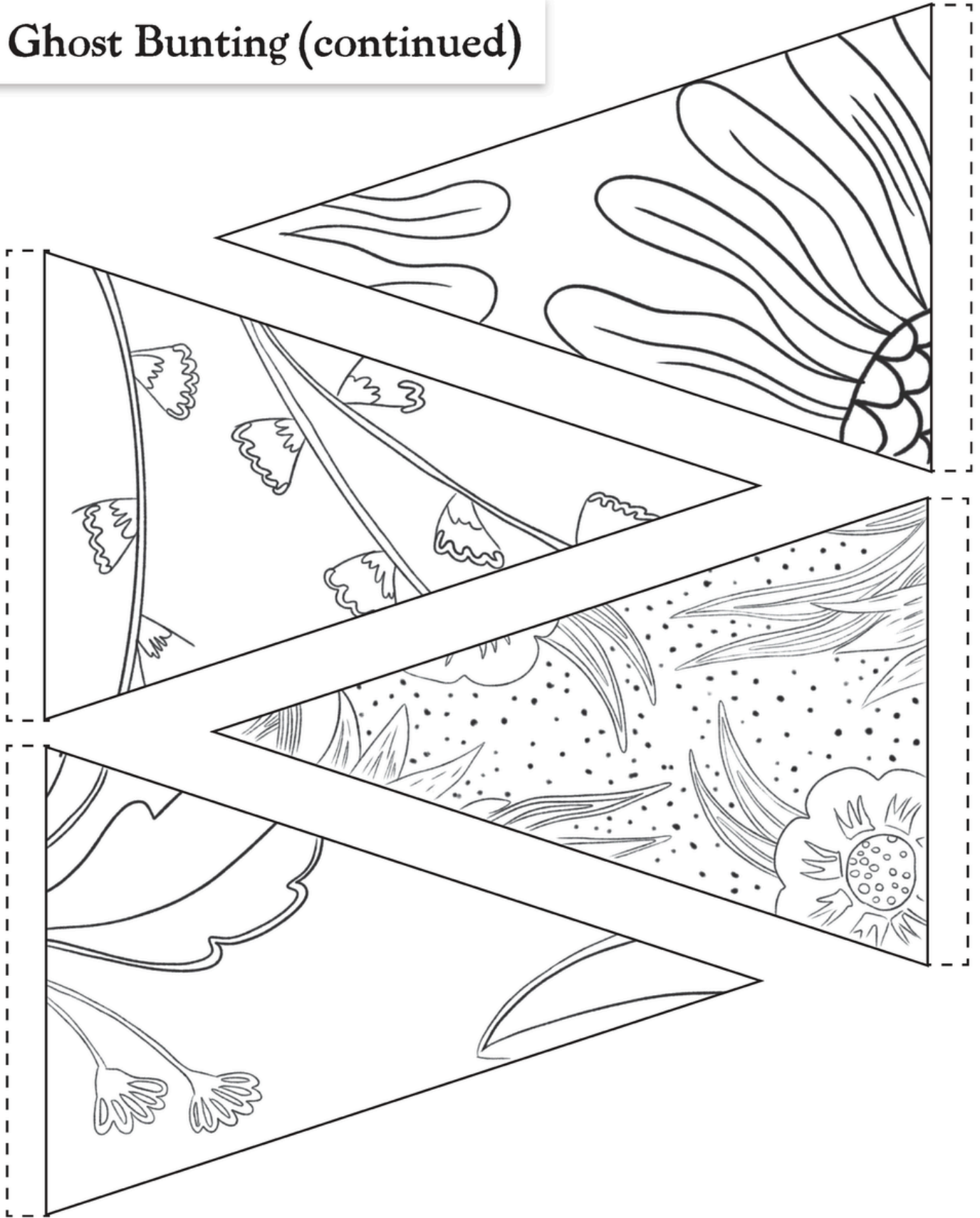
Cut your tape into small pieces, then use them to attach the little ghosts to the string. Hang your newly created bunting!



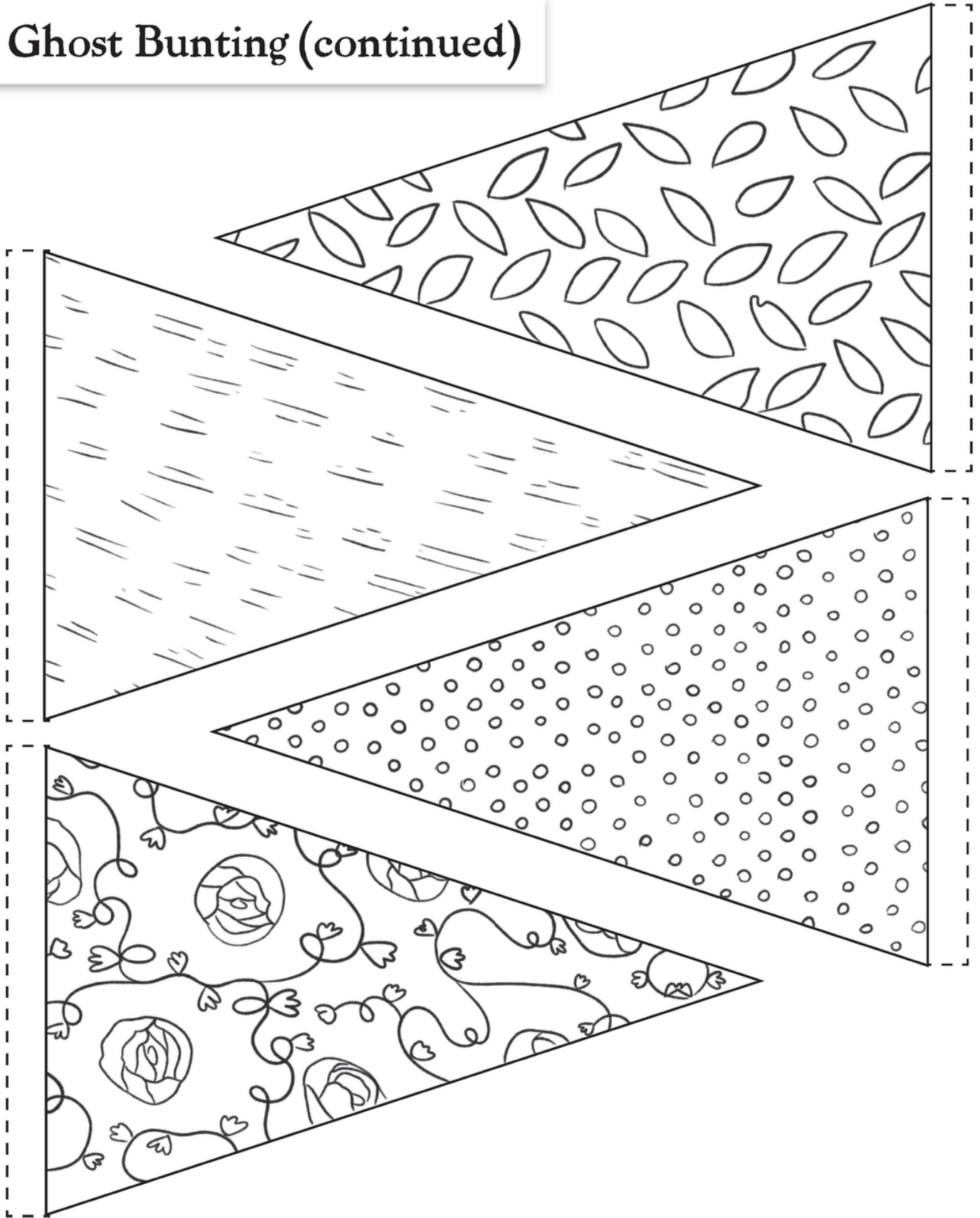

Lollipop Ghosts



In *The Little Ghost Who Was a Quilt*, the little ghost sees a branch trimmed with lollipop ghosts. If you have extra fabric, you can make a whole family of lollipop ghosts — maybe there's even a lace one like the little ghost's great-grandmother! Ghosts can be all shapes, sizes and colors.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Different types of fabric (any pattern)
- Round lollipops
- A marker
- String or ribbon

STEP 1:

Cut your fabric so it is about the size of a tissue.

STEP 2:

Place the cut fabric over the lollipop (make sure the lollipop is still wrapped up so your ghost does not get sticky!).

STEP 3:

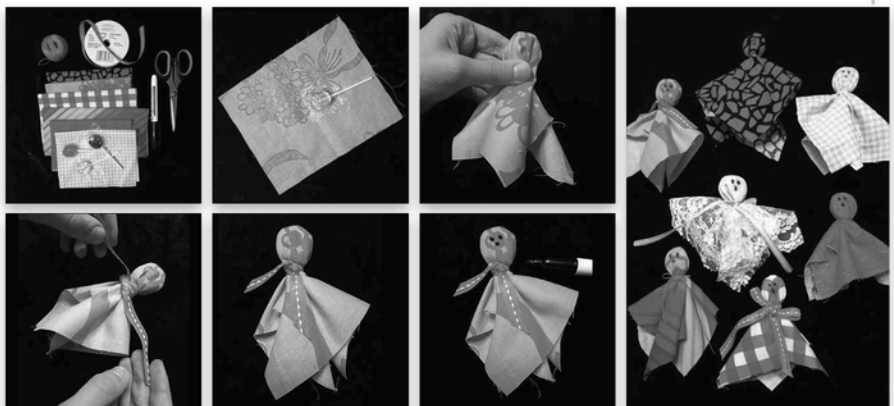
Add a ribbon or string around the base of the lollipop so that there's a separate head and body. Tie the ribbon or string into a knot or bow.

STEP 4:

Draw eyes and a mouth onto your ghost's head.

STEP 5:

Decorate! Put your lollipop ghosts in a container or hang them on a branch.



Ornament

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Scissors
- Hole puncher
- String
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- Optional: Additional decorations (tissue paper, stickers, fabric)

STEP 1:

Color and decorate the little ghost below.

STEP 2:

Carefully cut out your completed little ghost.

STEP 3:

Punch a hole in the top of your ghost ornament. Put the string through the hole and hang your newly created ornament! Alternatively, you can tape a Popsicle stick to the little ghost to make it into a puppet!
